Mr. KENNEDY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on _____

A BILL

To require the advice and consent of the Senate for any modification to the 1966 agreement between the United States and the United Kingdom concerning the British Indian Ocean Territory, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

4 In this Act:

5 (1) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CON-
6 GRESS.—The term “appropriate committees of Con-
7 gress” means—

1 (A) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
2 the Senate;

3 (B) the Committee on Armed Services of
4 the Senate; and

5 (C) the Committee on Appropriations of
6 the Senate.

7 (2) COVERED AGREEMENT.—The term “covered
8 agreement” means the Exchange of notes consti-
9 tuting an agreement concerning the availability for
10 defense purposes of the British Indian Ocean Terri-
11 tory, dated December 30, 1966.

12 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO MODIFICATION OF**
13 **AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE BRITISH IN-**
14 **DIAN OCEAN TERRITORY.**

15 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any modification to the covered
16 agreement shall require the advice and consent of the Sen-
17 ate.

18 (b) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—None of the
19 funds authorized to be appropriated, appropriated, or oth-
20 erwise made available for any Federal department or
21 agency may be obligated or expended to modify the cov-
22 ered agreement unless the Senate has provided advice and
23 consent for such modification.

24 (c) REPORT REQUIRED.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Before entering into any ne-
2 gotiation regarding modification of the covered
3 agreement, the President shall submit to the appro-
4 priate committees of Congress a report detailing the
5 following:

6 (A) The national security rationale for the
7 proposed modification.

8 (B) The implications of the proposed modi-
9 fication for United States operational control of
10 Diego Garcia.

11 (C) Any risks posed by third-party sov-
12 ereign claims or foreign military presence.

13 (2) FORM.—The report described in paragraph
14 (1) shall be submitted in classified and unclassified
15 form.
