**A BILL**

To restrict the ability of the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to adjust the rates for flood insurance coverage under the National Flood Insurance Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Flood Insurance Fair-  
5 ness Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CHARGEABLE PREMIUM RATES.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including  
8 section 1308 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968

1 (42 U.S.C. 4015), with respect to the chargeable premium  
2 rates described in subsection (a)(1) of that section, as in  
3 effect on the date of enactment of this Act, the Adminis-  
4 trator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency  
5 may not adjust those rates unless a duly enacted law of  
6 the United States enacted after the date of enactment of  
7 this Act provides the Administrator with that authority.
