I write to invite you or a designee from your company to appear before the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Financial Services and General Government to discuss contraband wireless device use by inmates in correctional facilities.

In testimony before the Subcommittee on June 16, 2020, Federal Communications Commission Chairman Ajit Pai specifically identified your company as not being proactive in finding a solution to this public safety problem. This hearing presents an opportunity for Subcommittee members to engage directly with the four wireless providers identified by Chairman Pai and to hear how your company plans to address the serious threat posed by contraband cell phones and potential next steps to eliminate this problem.
