Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle G of title XII, add the fol-
- 2 lowing:

1 **SEC. 1299L. PROHIBITION ON ALLOCATIONS OF SPECIAL**  
2 **DRAWING RIGHTS AT INTERNATIONAL MONE-**  
3 **TARY FUND FOR PERPETRATORS OF GENO-**  
4 **CIDE AND STATE SPONSORS OF TERRORISM**  
5 **WITHOUT CONGRESSIONAL AUTHORIZATION.**

6 Section 6 of the Special Drawing Rights Act (22  
7 U.S.C. 286q) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
8 lowing:

9 “(c) Unless Congress by law authorizes such action,  
10 neither the President nor any person or agency shall on  
11 behalf of the United States vote to allocate Special Draw-  
12 ing Rights under article XVIII, sections 2 and 3, of the  
13 Articles of Agreement of the Fund to a member country  
14 of the Fund, if the government of the member country  
15 has—

16 “(1) committed genocide at any time during the  
17 10-year period ending with the date of the vote; or

18 “(2) been determined by the Secretary of State,  
19 as of the date of the enactment of the National De-  
20 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2024, to  
21 have repeatedly provided support for acts of inter-  
22 national terrorism, for purposes of—

23 “(A) section 1754(c)(1)(A)(i) of the Ex-  
24 port Control Reform Act of 2018 (50 U.S.C.  
25 4813(c)(1)(A)(i));

1                   “(B) section 620A of the Foreign Assist-  
2                   ance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371);

3                   “(C) section 40(d) of the Arms Export  
4                   Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780(d)); or

5                   “(D) any other provision of law.”.
