- 3 SECTION 1. NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
- 5 rity and the Secretary of Health and Human Services
- 6 shall notify the governor of a State and the chief executive
- 7 officer of a unit of local government in such State of any
- 8 alien that is being transported by the Department of

6	(b) Information to Be Included.—Each notifica-
7	tion made pursuant to subsection (a) shall include—
8	(1) for each transported alien—
9	(A) his or her legal name, country of ori-
10	gin, age, and sex;
11	(B) any crimes for which such alien has
12	been convicted; and
13	(C) any criminal gang with which such
14	alien is or has been affiliated; and
15	(2) the types of security screenings that have
16	been performed with respect to such aliens.
