7 be used by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs under section
8 5502 of title 38, United States Code, in any case arising
9 out of the administration by the Secretary of laws and
10 benefits under such title, to report a person who is deemed

1 mentally incapacitated, mentally incompetent, or to be ex-
2 perencing an extended loss of consciousness as a person
3 who has been adjudicated as a mental defective under sub-
4 section (d)(4) or (g)(4) of section 922 of title 18, United
5 States Code, without the order or finding of a judge, mag-
6 istrate, or other judicial authority of competent jurisdic-
7 tion that such person is a danger to himself or herself
8 or others.
