6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7(a) of the Small Busi-  
7 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (36), by adding at the end the  
9 following:

1           “(W) PROHIBITION.—An applicant is not  
2 eligible to receive a covered loan if an owner of  
3 20 percent or more of the equity of the appli-  
4 cant has, as of the date of the application, been  
5 convicted of a felony in relation to a riot or civil  
6 disorder during the 2-year period preceding the  
7 date of the application.”; and

8           (2) in paragraph (37), by adding at the end the  
9 following:

10           “(P) PROHIBITION.—An applicant is not  
11 eligible to receive a covered loan if an owner of  
12 20 percent or more of the equity of the appli-  
13 cant has, as of the date of the application, been  
14 convicted of a felony in relation to a riot or civil  
15 disorder during the 2-year period preceding the  
16 date of the application.”.

17           (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-  
18 section (a) shall apply with respect to an application for  
19 a loan under paragraph (36) or (37) of section 7(a) of  
20 the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)) that is  
21 submitted on or after the date of enactment of this Act.
