A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey to the city of Eunice, Louisiana, certain Federal land in the State of Louisiana, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Save the Liberty The-
5 atre Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) CITY.—The term “City” means the city of
9 Eunice, Louisiana.

1 (2) MAP.—The term “map” means the map en-
2 titled “Jean Lafitte National Historical Park and
3 Preserve, Proposed Boundary Revision and Dis-
4 posal”, numbered 467/168813, and dated December
5 2020.

6 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
7 the Secretary of the Interior.

8 **SEC. 3. LAND CONVEYANCE.**

9 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORITY.—The Secretary shall
10 convey to the City, by quitclaim deed and without consid-
11 eration, all right, title, and interest of the United States
12 in and to the parcels of land described in subsection (b).

13 (b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcels of land re-
14 ferred to in subsection (a) are lots 5 and 6, less the north
15 27 feet of lot 5, Block 22, of the Original Townsite of
16 Eunice, Louisiana, generally depicted as “Proposed Dis-
17 posal Area” on the map.

18 (c) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
19 and available for public inspection in the appropriate of-
20 fices of the National Park Service.

21 **SEC. 4. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.**

22 On the conveyance to the City of the land described
23 in section 3(b), the boundary of the Jean Lafitte National
24 Historical Park and Preserve shall be adjusted to ex-
25 clude—

- 1 (1) the conveyed land; and
- 2 (2) lots 7 and 8 of the Original Townsite of Eu-
- 3 nice, Louisiana, generally depicted as “Non-NPS in
- 4 Current Boundary” on the map.
