**A BILL**

To clarify that section 8526(7) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 does not apply with respect to the use of funds for sports clubs, teams, training, or related activities provided for students.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Allowing for Rec-  
5 reational Resources for Outdoor Wellness Act" or the  
6 "ARROW Act".

1 **SEC. 2. EXCEPTION.**

2 Section 8526(7) of the Elementary and Secondary  
3 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7906(7)) is amended  
4 by inserting “, except that this paragraph shall not apply  
5 to the use of funds under this Act for sports clubs, teams,  
6 training, or related activities provided for students” before  
7 the period at the end.
